While Staveley thrives on variety, our trips follow a very regular pattern. This enables parents to be able to predict and budget for future expenditure. The pattern for residential visits is given below.

* This residential is for outdoor / adventurous activities and takes place annually but alternating between Fellside (nr Caldbeck) and Hawse End (Keswick). It is offered in the first instance to Y5 pupils with any remaining capacity being offered to Y4 pupils. It is possible therefore that some pupils may attend in both Y4 and Y5 but this is an occasional opportunity rather than the expected norm.
